A complete set of Tendering Document(s) in English and additional sets may be purchased by interested Tenderers on the submission of a written application to the address given under paragraph 4 above and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Tshs100,000/-, Payment should either be by Cash, Banker's Draft, or Banker's Cheque, payable to District Executive Director – Ludewa.


6. All Tenders must be accompanied by a Tender Securing Declaration in the format provided in tendering document

7. All Tenders in one original plus three (3) copies properly filled in, and enclosed in plain envelopes must be delivered to the address Tender Board Secretary P.O.Box 19 Ludewa District Council room no 18 Boma Offices at or before 10.00am

on Friday 09th June, 2017. Tenders will be opened promptly at 10:30am on Friday 09th June, 2017 in public and in the presence of Tenderers' representatives who choose to attend in the opening at the Boma Conference Hall.

8. Site visit will be held on 2nd June, 2017 at 10.00 a.m starting from the Ludewa District Executive Director Office. The costs of visiting the site shall be at the tenderers own expense.

9. Late tenders, portion of tenders, electronic tenders, tenders not received, tenders not opened and not read out in public at the tender opening ceremony shall not be accepted for evaluation irrespective of the circumstance.
